WIOA Youth is a program through the department of Workforce Services that helps eligible students improve their employability and become successful adults.

Eligibility:

- Ages 14-24
- US Citizen or eligible to work in the US
- Enrolled in school and meet one or more of the following:
 - o Have a disability,
 - o In foster care,
 - o Have difficulties with school attendance
 - o A refugee
- Complete a basic skills assessment
- Have a desire to succeed and be willing to apply yourself.

Services Provided:

- Career planning and Job Search assistance
- Leadership/volunteer opportunities
- Mentoring and guidance counseling
- Internships and on the job training
- Pre-apprenticeship training
- Basic Skills Assistance
- Funding for Post-Secondary Training
- Cash incentives for completion of certain tasks
